- 2. Treasurer's Report was not available

- 3. LB373. Seat belts for school buses. Rich Casey testified for Bellevue Public Schools opposing this bill. The Nebraska School Board Association also testified against the bill. Our organization didn't get any feed back from members as to what the association's "majority" stand is on the bill.
 - a. Other feedback: May be too controversial and concerns on the liability to the Association should we take a stand. Kevin with Cummins and the was neutral on this. An idea brought to the floor is to use a committee to develop a position.
 - b. The bill did not make it out of the legislative Committee this year.
- 4. LB248. To prohibit use of interactive wireless devices by school bus drivers. There was no testimony against this bill and it did make it out of committee.
- 5. We will not be mailing out Newsletters however members can get the Newsletter from the website.
- 6. President Dave's "Radical Hospitality" Goal is to engage communication with the Association's members and non-members throughout Nebraska.
